Dedication Caps Portiuncula Journey

The Dedication and Blessing of the new Franciscan Monastery of St. Clare held on the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord, March 25, 2015 was a significant and joyfilled event that brought “The Portiuncula Journey” to a close. The building project of the Poor Clare Sisters was called the “Portiuncula Journey” because the “little portion” of land on lease for its construction belonged to Mount Michael Abbey. “Portiuncula” literally means “little portion”.

St. Francis gathered the first friars for prayer in the Portiuncula in Assisi, which belonged to the Benedictines, who allowed him to have it. In return, Francis offered them a basket of fish. That was the start of the Franciscan-Benedictine connection that is echoed in the “Portiuncula Journey” of the Poor Clare Sisters in Omaha. The journey of building on Benedictine land is completed. The Poor Clare Sisters have moved into the new monastery on the 18th of March 2015. And the Dedication and Blessing had taken place. In this first issue from the new monastery, the design of the Portiuncula in the masthead gives way to the picture of the monastery on 22625 Edgewater Road.

Archbishop George J. Lucas presided the Dedication and Blessing, assisted by Deacon Terry Ficenec and Rev. James M. Weeder. Among the priests who concelebrated were: Rt. Rev. Michael Liebl, OSB; Very Rev. Michael Jennrich, OFM, Vicar Provincial of the Sacred Heart Province, who gave the homily; Rt. Rev. Theodore Wolff, OSB; Rt. Rev. Raphael Walsh, OSB; Rev. Richard Hauser, SJ; and Rev. Daniel Soltys. Guests for the event were Sister Dianne Short, OSC, president of the Mother Magdalen Bentivoglio Federation; Sister Carolyn Forgette, OSC, president of the Holy Name Federation; Sister Rita Louise, OSC of the monastery in Spokane; and Sister Luisa, OSC, who came from Cincinnati to help with the singing.

In her engaging words of welcome, Sister Theresina Santiago recalled interesting and important aspects of the “Portiuncula Journey” that took seven years and seven months. She brought to the attention of her Poor Clare Sisters, the advisory council and committee members, and the majority of benefactors and friends present; the significance of coming together for the special event that takes place on the Solemnity of the Annunciation, and on the Year of Consecrated Life!

After the blessing of water, of the people, of the whole Portiuncula Chapel, and the altar, the relics of St. Clare of Assisi, St. Celine of France, and of martyrs Saints Felician, Innocent & Theophilus were deposited under the Altar. The two readings were read by Sister Virginia Hassing, OSC and Sister Kathleen Hawkins, OSC. Jim Czyz was leader for the Prayers of the Faithful. At the Presentation of the Gifts, Sister Mary Joseph Nyankindi, OSC and Sister Anthony Assey, OSC offered a vase of flowers each at the statue of St. Francis and St. Clare. Connie Cosentino laid a bouquet of flowers at the Altar, Sister Mary Clare Brown, OSC and Sister Maria Cervenova, OSC offered the bread and the wine.

Guest artists for the special liturgy included Jim Nailon, guitar; Christine Mehser, OFS, bass, Anne Madison, organ. Dryden Meints sang the Lord’s Prayer and Paula Wallace gave a rendition of the Ave Maria. After the Post Communion Prayer, Archbishop Lucas, led by Sister Theresina and the Poor Clares, blessed the whole monastery. The assembly remained in the Chapel singing the Litany of the Saints. After the Concluding Rite, light brunch was served by Wheatfields at the San Damiano Hall.

Omaha Troops To Poor Clare Monastery

The Poor Clare Sisters and their Advisory Council were overwhelmingly surprised on Sunday, the 8th of February 2015, by the number of persons that showed up at the open house of the new monastery! It was Open House Day for religious communities in the United States, as part of the celebration of the Year of Consecrated Life. The parking lot as well as Edgewater Road were both occupied for the scheduled event 2:00-4:00 pm. Some arrived before two o'clock, others came after four, and there were those who had to give up for lack of parking, and inability to walk and fall in line to enter the monastery! The registration team could not cope up with the number of over fifteen hundred people continuously streaming into the chapel.

for the number of people mainly from Omaha, with some from Arkansas, Iowa and Illinois.

The open house was a good opportunity for those who came like pilgrims, to tour the whole monastery, including the enclosure area, because the Poor Clare Sisters had not as yet transferred to their new home. All were delighted with what they saw. Many who have been supporting the building project were happy to see where and how their hard earned dollars were well spent for a monastery with guest areas to serve God's People. Vocation inquiries were brought up, as well as prayer requests, and requests for days of prayer and reflection. The hunger for a "time apart with the Lord" in the quiet atmosphere of the monastery surroundings was evident.

The objective of the open house was to give the people the opportunity to know more about the religious community. Those gathered in the Chapel of the Portiuncula heard the Poor Clare Story before touring the facility. Sister Theresina told them about the San Damiano Crucifix, the mural depicting the investiture of St. Clare, the Portiuncula altar of the Blessed Sacrament, and the canvas painting of the Annunciation. The Chapel, which is the central and biggest part of the monastery was crowded and not big enough

Those who came to the open house were served wine and horsedoeuves prepared by Wheatfields. It was a beautiful sunny winter day, and all enjoyed the beauty of God's creation. The Poor Clare Sisters are happy and grateful to all who came, to those who signed up for the wish lists of items needed in the different rooms of the monastery, to the team that prepared for the open house. The event did "WAKE UP THE WORLD" and confirmed that the new Poor Clare Monastery is God's will for His People!
